# PRE CHARITY WALK FOR PEACE - RECEPTION LUNCH

and Humanity First.



The event started at 2pm immediately after the 2nd obligatory prayers of the day - *the Zuhr prayer* - with the recitation of Holy Qur'an, followed by its English translation.

Kashif Ahmed, the CWFPP Regional Coordinator, welcomed the guests and thanked them for sparing their valuable time to attend the proceedings.

An audio-video presentation about the humanitarian efforts of Charity Walk for Peace was played to the audience highlighting various aspects such as tree-planting; feeding the homeless; foodbank support; and the numerous charity walks held all over the UK.



The next part of the programme included various charities being donated funds for their humanitarian projects. A guest from each organisation explained their work and how funds from Charity Walk for Peace helps them to care for so many people.





A further video was shared with the audience explaining how the charities can become associated with CWFPP through its Affiliate Programme.
